Check if You're Eligible

Visit jobsandhope.wv.gov to see if you qualify and learn if this program is right for you.



Ask yourself if you're ready to start education or training and if you have a career goal in mind.

Do you have a phone number or email address your Transition Agent can use to contact you?



Start Your Journey

If you're eligible, go to the "Start Your Journey" section at jobsandhope.wv.gov or call 833-784-1385 to get started.

Referral Received

Once we receive your referral, a Transition Agent will reach out to help you get started.



Transition Agents are positioned statewide to cover all 55 counties!

Check your email and missed calls regularly. Transition Agents need to hear from you.



Connect With a Transition Agent

Your Transition Agent will reach out to begin the intake process and help you become a participant.

Intake Process

You'll need to complete a drug screen and answer questions about your employment goals and any barriers you're facing.



Be prepared to know your barriers and goals and don't be late – there's work to do!

It's never too late to learn something new!



Education & Training

Once you're an active participant, you'll need to complete one education or training course each month.

Eligible For Services

Some services are available right away, while others are available after 90 days of enrollment and completing an education or training course.



After 90 days, you'll be eligible for more services!

Think of your Transition Agent as a resource guide – they know the right people to help you.



Barriers Breakdown

Your Transition Agent will help you remove barriers to employment as you progress through the program.

Career Employment

Once you've completed your education and training, your Transition Agent will help you find a job in your desired industry.



Paycheck, benefits, and time off – life is looking better!

Barriers Are Removed

After finding career employment, you and your Transition Agent will see how your barriers are being removed.

Graduation

Once you've secured career employment and removed all your barriers, you'll graduate from the Jobs & Hope WV program.

Do you have stable housing?

Stable housing is key to success in Jobs & Hope WV. It provides the foundation for education, training, and employment. Without secure housing, focusing on personal development can be tough. That's why it's important to assess this need early.



Are you able to pass an eligibility screen?

Passing an eligibility screen is required for the program. It's important to be aware of this early in the process. This step helps ensure you're ready for the next phase and supports a healthier, more stable lifestyle.



Do you have a cell phone and email?

Having a cell phone and email is essential for staying in touch with your Transition Agent. These tools help you get updates on job opportunities, training programs, and other important resources, so you stay connected and engaged.



Are you able to attend a training or education program?

Willingness to attend education or training is required for the Jobs & Hope WV program, as it helps participants gain the skills needed to secure meaningful employment.



Are you ready to take the next step toward a career?
